## FOREWORD

The report of the Chief Electoral Officer on the proceedings of the 37<sup>th</sup> Nova Scotia Provincial General Election held on June 13, 2006 is being presented in two volumes. Volume I, *Statement of Votes & Statistics* published in October, 2006 gives the recapitulation on the election, identifies elected members, official agents and senior election officers, summarizes election results and provides detailed results and statistics by voting area (poll by poll results) as well as by candidate gender and historically by election. Volume II of the report, *Financial Information & Statistics* published in March, 2007 following completion of accounts, provides financial information on election expenses, candidate reimbursement, election administration costs and financial and comparative statistics.

The Fifty-Ninth General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia was dissolved on May 13, 2006 and election writs were issued by the Chief Electoral Officer that same day. Nomination day was May 30, 2006 and ordinary polling day was June 13, 2006. No candidates being returned by acclamation, a poll was held in all electoral districts.

In the June 13, 2006 general election, 210 candidates were nominated and ran for election: 52 from each of the Progressive Conservative Association of Nova Scotia, Nova Scotia New Democratic Party and Green Party of Nova Scotia; and 51 from the Nova Scotia Liberal Party. Three independent candidates also stood for election. Elected to the House of Assembly at the June 13, 2006 general election were 23 Progressive Conservatives, 20 New Democrats and 9 Liberals.

Of the total number of candidates who stood for election, 134 received the required threshold of 15% of the valid votes cast in their electoral districts, qualifying them for reimbursement of a portion of their election expenses from public funding. Total reimbursement paid to these 134 candidates amounted to \$2,301,080.71 in 2006. By comparison, in the 36<sup>th</sup> general election held on August 5, 2003, 144 out of 189 candidates standing for election received public funding totalling \$2,159,125.92. In the 35<sup>th</sup> general election held on July 27, 1999, 142 out of 178 candidates received public funding totalling \$1,954,542.56.

Approved election expenses of candidates and recognized parties for the June 13, 2006 general election were \$5,768,170.08. By comparison candidates and recognized parties reported expenses of \$5,552,951.28 in 2003 and \$5,316,426.83 in 1999.

Total administration costs to the Province for the 2006 general election excluding reimbursement to candidates and election expense audit fees were \$3,883,627.91. This figure includes all direct costs to the electoral district returning offices, costs incurred by Elections Nova Scotia to ready all districts for the election and to actually administer it, as well as the costs of supplies, materials, computer equipment, software, election officer training, consulting services and any other related expenses, which are expended between elections to ensure ongoing election readiness. Since the timing of a general election is unpredictable when a minority government is in place, significant election readiness costs are unavoidable.

Total cost of the June 13, 2006 general election (administration costs, readiness costs, candidate reimbursement costs and fees for audit of election expenses reports) was \$6,248,277.09. This gives a cost per elector for the June 13, 2006 general election of \$9.22.

This report also contains a *Statement of Votes & Statistics* and *Financial Information & Statistics* on the Chester-St. Margaret's By-election which took place on June 21, 2005. A brief report on the Halifax Citadel By-election is also included. This by-election, originally scheduled for June 21, 2006, was superseded and the writ withdrawn by the dissolution of the House of Assembly and the issuance of the writs of election for the June 13, 2006 general election.

Lastly, this report contains a number of reports, tables and figures relating to election financing in order to present data in various formats for ease of understanding as well as to assist the Chief Electoral Officer in identifying and evaluating potential election administration efficiencies.

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# 1. Introduction

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## **SPENDING LIMITS AND ELECTION EXPENSES REPORTING AND REIMBURSEMENT**

Determination of spending limits for election campaigns and reporting of candidate and recognized party election expenses are important components of the campaign finance regime in Nova Scotia. The *Elections Act* sets out formulas by which candidate and recognized party spending limits are established. Within designated periods following an election, official agents of candidates and of recognized parties are required to file reports of election expenses in prescribed form accompanied by an affidavit, audit report and supporting invoices, receipts and other vouchers. All expense report filings receive a detailed compliance review by the Chief Electoral Officer and her financial staff. It is a statutory obligation of the Chief Electoral Officer to be satisfied that expenses reported are election expenses as defined in the *Elections Act* and were incurred within the authorized time frame before full reimbursement from public funds is paid. Election expenses of candidates are published soon after filing with the returning officers following an election. Both election expenses as originally filed and published and as adjusted by the Chief Electoral Officer have been posted on the Elections Nova Scotia website, [www.electionsnovascotia.ns.ca](http://www.electionsnovascotia.ns.ca).

At the time of the June 13, 2006 general election, recognized parties were not entitled to receive any form of public funding but election expenses are limited by law and reporting and publishing of these expenses is required. Recognized party expenses were published in the Royal Gazette Part I on November 22, 2006. They are also available on the Elections Nova Scotia website.

Volume II of the report on the June 13, 2006 general election also includes the costs associated with preparing for the actual delivery of the election. These are referred to as 'election readiness' costs typically expended by Elections Nova Scotia as distinct from actual election delivery costs. Where election readiness costs were identified by Elections Nova Scotia as being related to the June 13, 2006 general election, regardless of the fiscal year in which they were they were incurred, they have been included in total election administration costs and pro-rated on the basis of number of electors to each electoral district.

Effort has been made to include in this report all of the costs of administering the election. Only with this approach is it possible to determine an accurate cost per elector of administering the election. For the June 13, 2006 general election the cost per elector was \$9.22. Cost per elector was not reflected in the *Statement of Votes & Financial Statistics* for the August 5, 2003 Provincial General Election, or in earlier election reports.

Lastly, this report contains a number of reports, charts and graphs relating to election financing in order to present data in various formats for ease of understanding as well as to assist the Chief Electoral Officer in identifying and evaluating potential election administration efficiencies.

Figure 2.2 RECOGNIZED PARTY EXPENSES

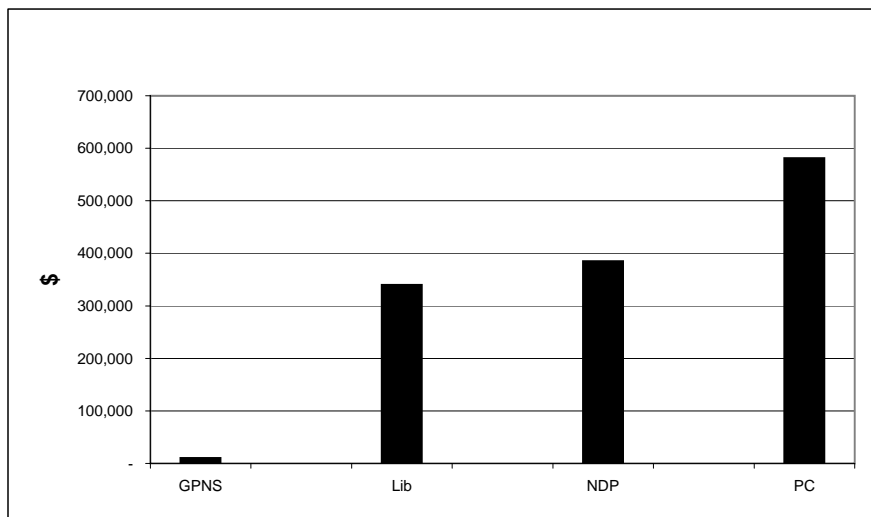
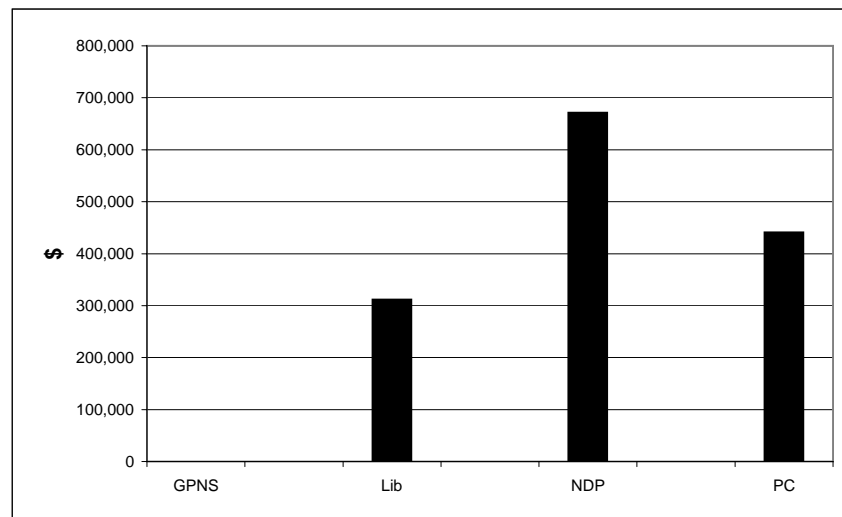


Figure 2.3 RECOGNIZED PARTY EXPENSES TRANSFERRED TO CANDIDATES

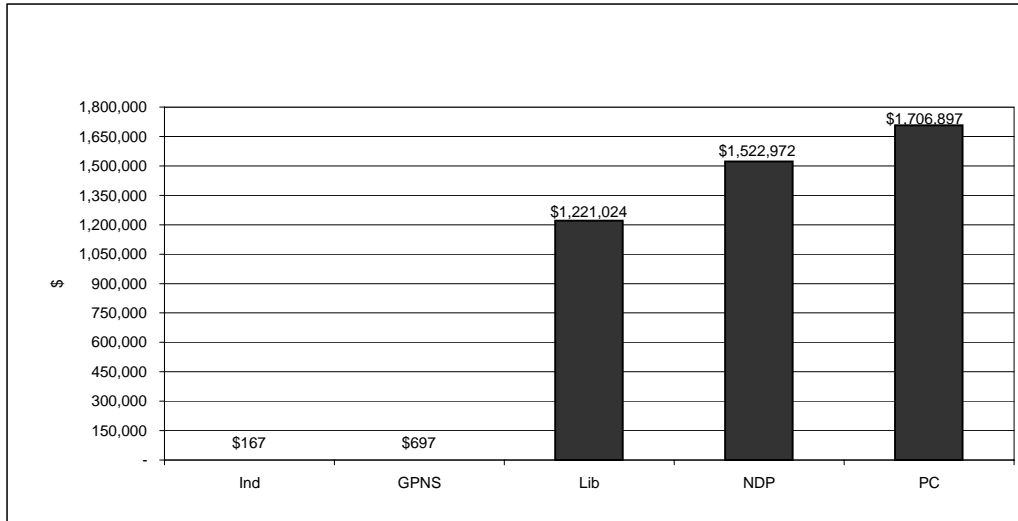

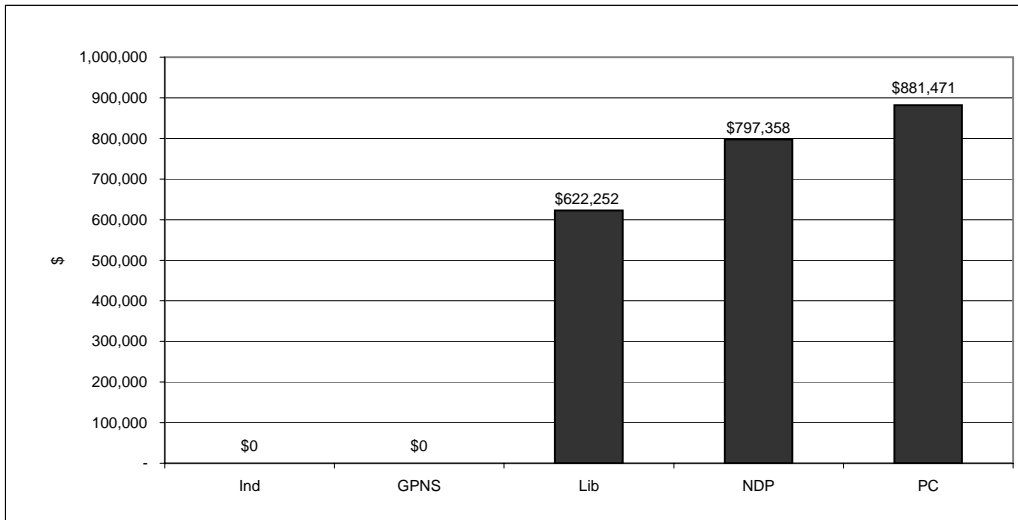

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## 6. Halifax Citadel By-election

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6.1 BACKGROUND

The writ for a by-election in Halifax Citadel to fill a vacant seat in the House of Assembly was issued on April 5, 2006 setting Ordinary Polling Day as June 27, 2006. That by-election was superseded and the writ withdrawn by dissolution of the House of Assembly on May 13, 2006 and the issuance of the writs for the provincial general election on June 13, 2006. At the time of the call of the general election only two candidates had been nominated for the by-election.

The Halifax Citadel By-election was unusual in two respects. Firstly, the election period would have been unusually long had it come to fruition, being 83 days from the writ to Ordinary Polling Day. A typical writ period is usually close to the minimum number of days required by law, that is, 30 days. That meant the Tariff of Fees and Expenses had to be adjusted to reflect a longer time period of employment of returning office staff. Hours of operation were also reduced to reflect reduced activity in the returning office over the longer writ period. The only poll opened was the Write-in Ballot Poll since the general election was called before the Special Poll commenced. Secondly, this by-election was unusual insofar as it was superseded by a provincial general election and the *Elections Act* does not specifically address how election expenses, reimbursement and return of nomination fees are to be handled under such circumstances. No reimbursement to candidates was paid and election expenses were pro-rated as between the by-election and the general election. The costs detailed below represent the returning office costs related to the by-election, with those costs being incurred between April 5, 2006 and May 13, 2006.

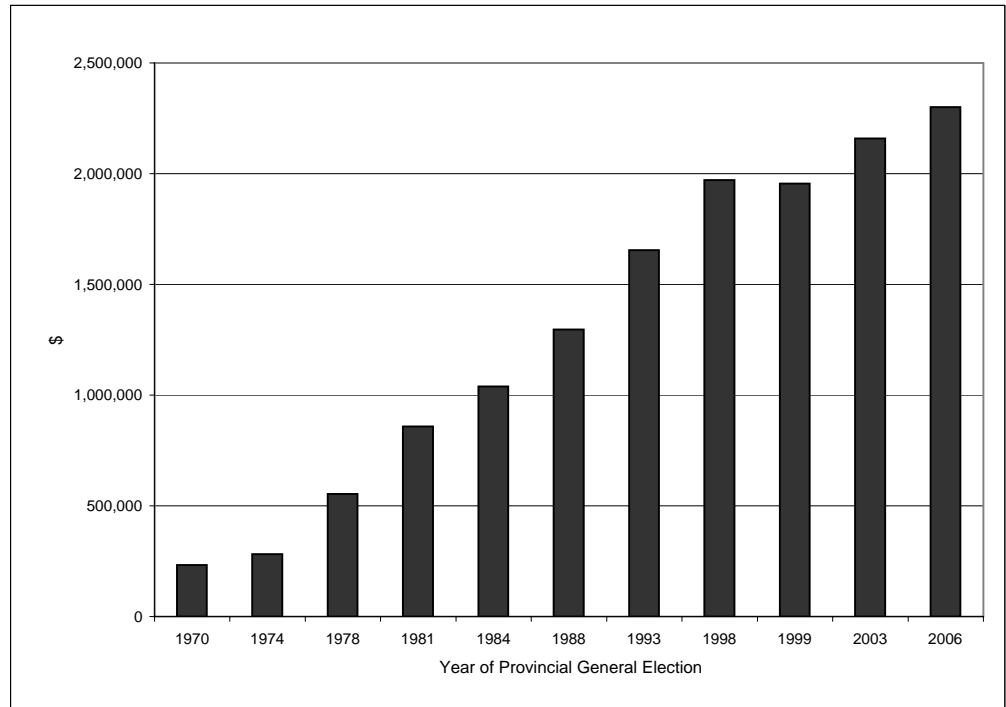

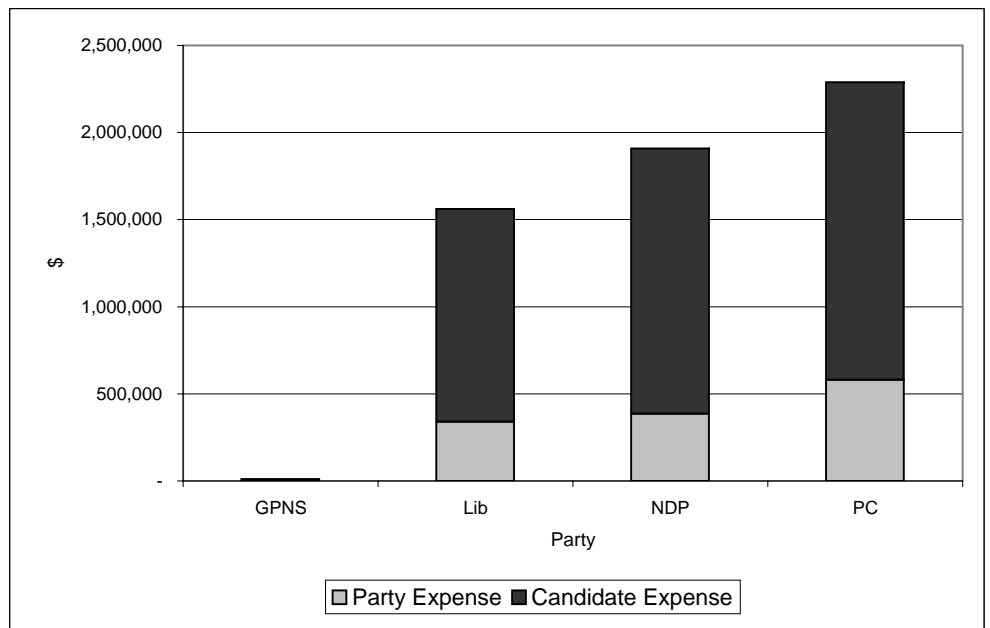
