

Instructions on how to complete the Application For Write-in ballot / Registration On the List of Electors

Fill in all sections of the form and print clearly.

1. **Name:** enter your full name, including your middle name or initial. The middle name helps to improve accuracy of the List of Electors.
2. **Gender:** This information helps to identify electors with names common to both genders.
3. **Date of Birth:** This information WILL NOT appear on the List of Electors, it is confidential. The date of birth helps to identify electors with the same name.
4. **Current Civic Address:** This is your street address and not a post office box or rural route number. It identifies the polling division in which you live.
5. **Civic Address of previous residence in Nova Scotia:** Your name may appear on the List of Electors at your previous address if you have recently moved. If so, your name will be transferred to your current address.
6. **Telephone Number:** This number WILL NOT appear on the List of Electors. It will be used by the Returning Office staff to contact you if more information is required about this application. Please provide an alternate phone number where you can be contacted if you are away from home.
7. **Mailing Address:** Fill in only if you get your mail at this address, and not at your civic address.
8. **Address to Send Ballot:** Fill in only if you want to receive your voting kit at this address.
9. **Declaration:** You must declare that you are qualified to vote by Write-in ballot. You must sign and date the declaration.

Documents Required: Attach photocopies of documents that prove your identity and residence. Do not send originals. The proof can be a copy of one document with your name, address and signature (column 1), or copies of two pieces of identification, one with your name and address (column 2) and the other with your name and signature (column 3). (*See examples below*)

Appointment of an Agent: If you are ill or disabled and need assistance, you may ask your Returning Office for a form to appoint an agent to receive and return your Write-in ballot. Your agent can be another elector who lives in your polling division and who is not an agent for another elector OR the agent can be a child, grandchild, brother, sister, parent, grandparent or spouse who lives in Nova Scotia and will be qualified to vote on election day.
